

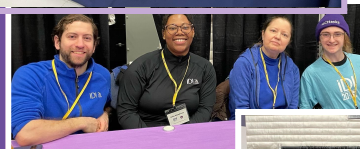

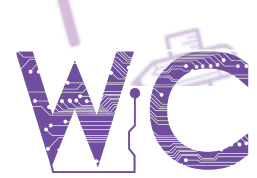

## Tech Talks

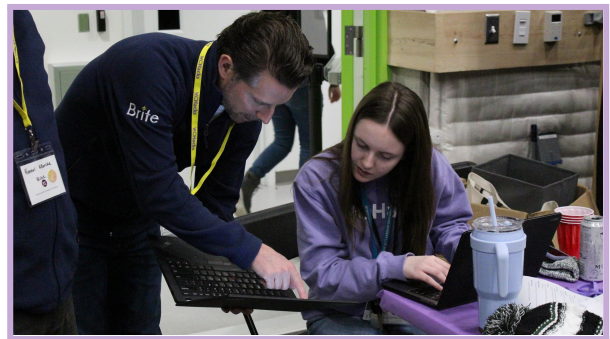


Tech Talks are focused on discussing theory, intra- or interpersonal concepts around computing, or other similar concepts.

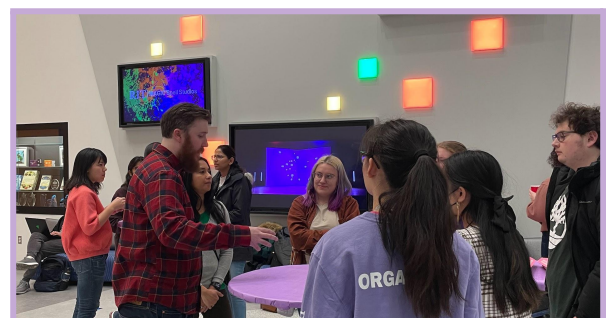
## Company Representatives

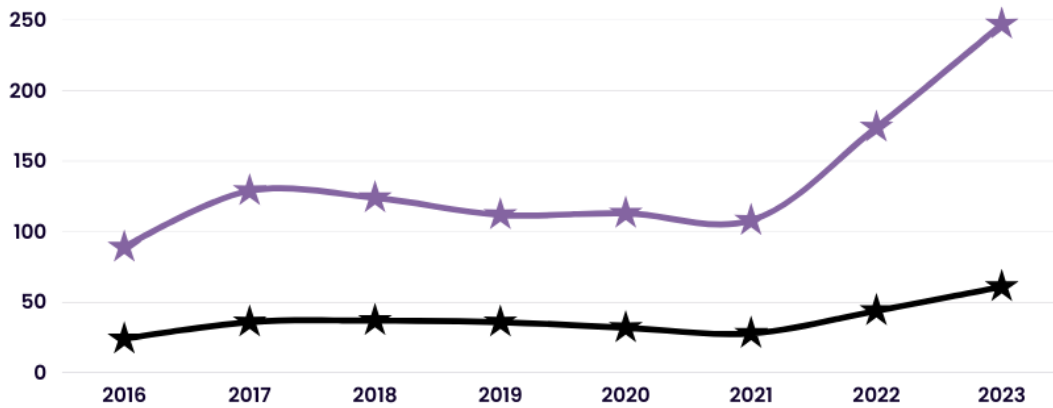
## Midnight Snack
